Week of March 30, 2020

Lesson Title: Tell Stories

Materials: Dinosaurs, papers and pencils

Back up materials: Papers and pencils

Beginning: parent and child will have a conversation about dinosaurs.

Middle: Parent will ask the child to tell her/him their own story about dinosaurs and let her/him know that they will write it down. The parent will write down on a paper exactly what the child says. The parent should not interrupt the child while he/she is telling the story.

End: At the end of the story, parent will read the story to the child. The child will listen to the story and then will add to the story if he/she would like to.

Through this lesson, the student will practice vocabulary as he/she tells the story. Also, by telling stories the children will learn sequences.
