Activity 1: Song

Learning Objectives: Language Development and Gross Motor. Materials: Good morning song "Hello"

Activity 2: Bean Sorting

Learning Objectives: Math (sorting, classifying, counting, number recognition), Color Recognition, One To One Correspondence, Fine Motor, and Language/Vocabulary. **Materials:** Assortment of different beans, and a bean-sorting chart

Activity Description:

- Teachers will email families a bean-sorting chart, for families to use with their children, or to help theme create their own.
- Families will provide an assortment of different beans to their children, and talk with them about the different size, shape, color, and name of beans.
- Families and children will then sort their beans on the bean chart.

Extension of Learning:

- Teachers will email charts.
- Sort and count beans on a bean counting chart.
- Play a bean matching game on a bean matching game chart with matching cards.

*These activities can be used with rocks as well (charts included).

Activity 3: Socks Match and Toss

Learning Objectives: Cognitive Development, Language Development, Identifying Colors and Patterns, Counting, and Gross Motor Movement. Materials: Different pairs of socks and laundry basket or hamper (box)

Activity Description:

- Families and children will find the match to their socks.
- Families and children will then toss the socks into laundry basket or hamper (small box).
