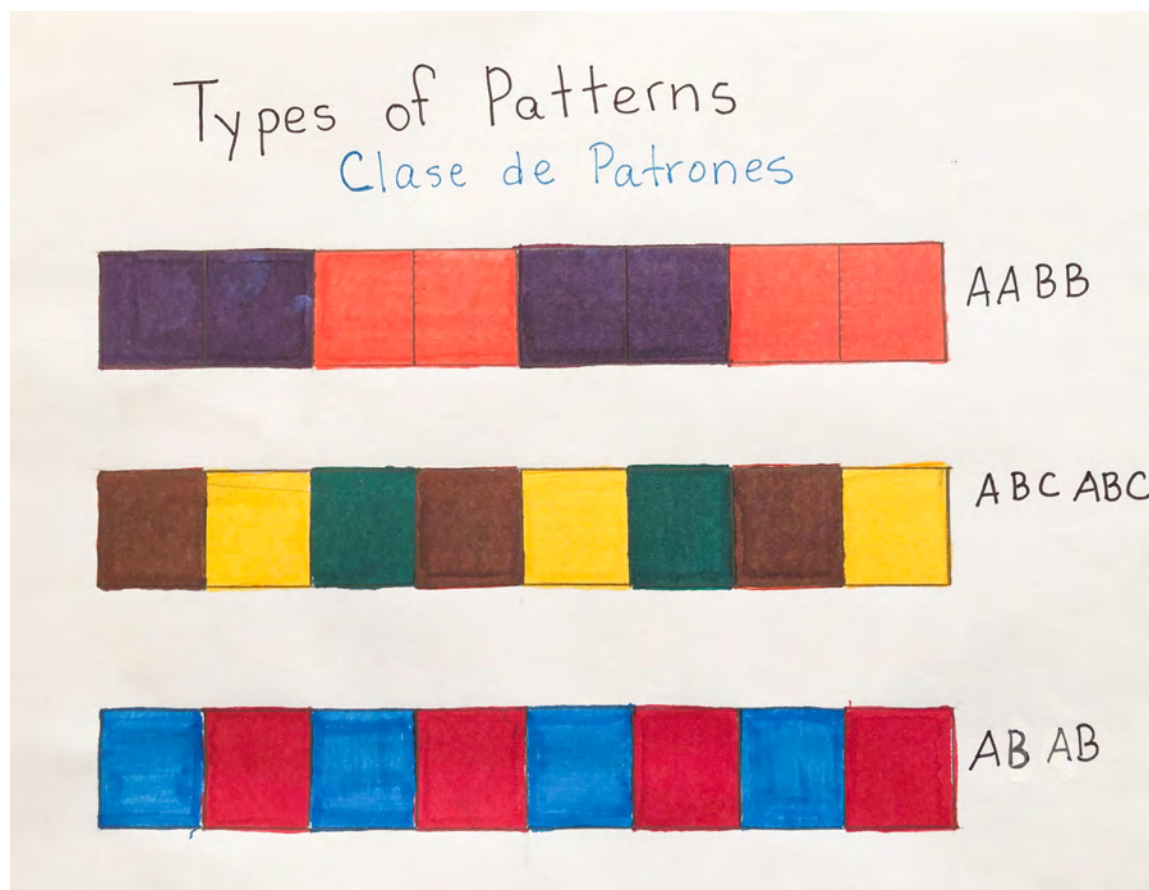

Classroom #6

Math

- a. Writing the missing number in the in the empty space helps you learn numbers in order and in-between. Do the page I sent for practice. You can make your own on paper writing in different numbers.
- b. By this time you should have Unifix cubes from Lakeshore. Please practice making different patterns with the cubes. There are a few patterns like ABAB, ABCABC and AABBAABB. Letters represent colors that you need to put together to create a pattern. I put an illustration as an example of patterns. When you make your own patterns with the cubes send me pictures.



Science

The last time we did planting it was in a plastic bag and taped to the window for sun and viewing. Lets try with soil this time.

- Gather all your materials. Soil, egg carton, seeds and water.
- Put some soil in each of the egg holders with the seeds in the middle
- Add some more soil to cover the seed and spray water.
- Finally, put where the carton of soil and seeds where it will get sun for growth. Spray water every 2-3 days. When transplanting you can cut up the individual seedlings and there is no need to discard the carton. Just replant it like that with at least 6 inches apart.

Self-regulation: What you know and what we want to know!

This self-regulation game is about sharing what you know and what you still want to learn. All children are very creative and inventive in their art and their ideas. Accomplishing task and demonstrating it makes them feel proud and smart. Teaching it is being able to problem solve and not being shy to ask for help if they cannot do something. It is working together and being part of a team.

Ask your child to draw something he is good at. It could be yoga, running, drawing, building, counting numbers, putting on their shoes, writing letters or numbers or eating. They should take their time in drawing this beautiful picture. Once it is drawn they can demonstrate it to others and ask them if they would like to be taught by him/her how to do it.

On another paper they can draw something they like to learn to do. They can show it to family members and ask them to teach them how to do it. Asking for help teaches how to problem solve, be less shy about asking, and builds relationships.
