**Activity:** Getting Dressed for Winter Weather

**Objectives:**



- Language Development
- Fine Motor Development
- Gross Motor/Body Awareness
- Self-Help Skills
- Following 1-2 step direction (i.e. take off your shoes and put them on the shelf)
- Family Connection



**Materials:**



- Winter accessories such as hats, gloves, scarfs, coats, socks and shoes that your child can easily put on and take off.



**Steps:**

- Introduce the activity by saying, when it's cold outside we wear \_\_\_\_\_. Can you try to put on your hat?
- You and your child can name the item of clothing.
- Identify body part associated with item of clothing.
- Provide context for why we wear a coat, hat, gloves, and ext. For example, you can say, in the winter we wear a coat because (give your child an opportunity to create the connection) ...it feels cold outside or to keep our body warm.
- Get the whole family involved! Bring out your winter clothing and play dress up with your child.

**Extension of Learning:**

- Comparing adult/child size gloves (big and small, short and long).
- Exploring different textures such as soft, fuzzy, bumpy, smooth, and rough.
- Exploring zippers, buttons, and laces
- Matching pairs of shoes, socks, and gloves
- Counting and one-to-one correspondence
