Activity: Ripped Paper Collage



Skills children develop:

- Language development/Vocabulary enhancement
- Fine motor skills (grip strength, pinch strength & squeezing)
- Sensory concept of stickiness
- Hand-Eye Coordination
- Creative arts

Materials:

- Ripped paper
- Construction paper or printer paper
- Glue bottles or glue sticks

Steps:

- Place ripped paper, paper, and glue on a table or floor (for child & parent).
- Let your child hold and explore with the ripped paper and glue.
- If your child seems to have difficulties, model for them, by gluing a piece of paper onto the construction paper.

Parents:

- Let your child choose and explore with their choice of materials.
- Imitate your child's actions - If your child is gluing, all their ripped paper on top of each other, you do the same.
- Describe your child's actions - If your child is gluing all their ripped paper on top of each other, you can say, **“you are gluing all your ripped paper on top of each other”**.
