


Yellow Room (TODDLERS) Gina C. & Annie Activity for the yearly of 02/15/

Activity for the week of 02/15/2021









Skills children develop:

- Language development/Vocabulary enhancement
- Fine motor skills (grip strength, pinch strength & squeezing)
- Sensory concept of stickiness
- Hand-Eye Coordination
- Creative arts

Materials:

- Ripped paper
- Construction paper or printer paper
- Glue bottles or glue sticks

Steps:

- Place ripped paper, paper, and glue on a table or floor (for child & parent).
- Let your child hold and explore with the ripped paper and glue.
- If your child seems to have difficulties, model for them, by gluing a piece of paper onto the construction paper.

Parents:

- Let your child choose and explore with their choice of materials.
- Imitate your child's actions If your child is gluing, all their ripped paper on top of each other, you do the same.
- Describe your child's actions If your child is gluing all their ripped paper on top of each other, you can say, "you are gluing all your ripped paper on top of each other".
